- ③ Indicate the operation of selecting a menu item or screen display with  and pressing .
- ④ Indicate the process of going to the next operation.

- Content at the bottom of the screen that can be operated by pressing  /  is indicated in parentheses, such as  (Back). However,  (Check) /  (Done) /  (Decide) /  (Confirm) are abbreviated as  only.

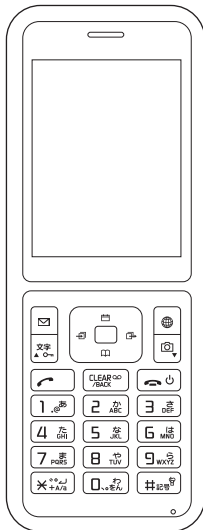

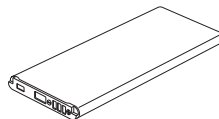
